The petitioners filed the present petition seeking protection of their lives and liberty expressing apprehension of danger from respondents No.6 and 7, parents of petitioner No.1.

Vide order dated 26.02.2019, direction was issued to learned State counsel to find out the existence of alleged threat.

On resumed hearing today, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh, P.S. Lopoke, Amritsar (Rural), has apprised the Court that the statements of the petitioners have been recorded wherein they have stated that now there is no threat to them. He has also placed on record the statements of the petitioners recorded by ASI Gurdeep Singh, P.S. Lopoke, Amritsar (Rural).

The fact of there being no threat to the petitioners at present is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioners also who prays for dismissal of the petition as withdrawn with liberty to file fresh petition for the purpose in case of any apprehension of danger from respondents No.6 and 7 or any of their relatives.

In the facts and circumstances, the prayer is accepted and the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file fresh petition in case of any apprehension of danger from respondents No.6 and 7 or any of their relatives.
