Though by this application (CRM-36258 of 2019), stay of proceedings before the trial Court during the pendency of accompanying petition is sought, on the ground that the matter having been compromised between the parties as already noticed by this Court while issuing notice of motion on 1.3.2019, further looking at the nature of the offence alleged to have been committed, it would be pointless to carry on with criminal proceedings.

It is seen that pursuant to the aforesaid order of this Court, even the report of the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nakodar, dated 24.4.2019, is on record, stating therein that the parties to this petition appeared in person in that Court and recorded their statements in terms of the compromise, which, as per the learned Magistrate, was arrived at

voluntarily.

The statement of respondent no.4, Pawandeep Kaur, i.e. the complainant in the FIR, has also been annexed with the report of the learned Magistrate.

A perusal thereof shows that she has stated that the matter having been compromised, she has no objection if the FIR is quashed, with Mr.Zoheb, Advocate, appearing for Mr.Umesh Kumar, Advocate for the complainant, also not denying that fact.

That being so, with the main petition itself being listed today at sr.no.275, it has been taken up.

In view of the compromise reached between the parties, looking at the nature of the offence, the petition is allowed with FIR no.466 dated 30.10.2005, having been registered at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar, for the alleged commission of an offence punishable under Section 380 of the IPC, along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, is hereby quashed.
