Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.127 dated 10.07.2015 registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC and Sections 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC (added later on) at Police Station Sadar, District Ludhiana and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

As per the allegations, the main accused had obtained the housing loan by fraudulently mortgaging the plot of the complainant. The allegations against the petitioner was that he being an empanelled valuer colluded with the main accused to get him this fraudulent loan.

Counsel for the petitioner has raised many points which as per

him showed that the petitioner had no connection with the offence.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Om Parkash has denied the argument of the counsel for the petitioner.

Be that as it may, all those issues are gone into by the trial Court and the case does not fall within the strict parameters of quashing.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed. However, the trial Court is directed to consider every application which the petitioner may move for exemption sympathetically.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
