GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. Petitioner-Ranjit Singh seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.9, dated 25.1.2019, at Police Station Kulgarhi, District Ferozepur, under Section 21 of NDPS Act.
2. The case of the prosecution is that co-accused Sukchain Singh was found in possession of 110 grams of 'heroin'. During the course of interrogation he disclosed that he had purchased the same from petitioner-Ranjit Singh.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he has falsely been implicated in the present case and had been nominated on the

basis of disclosure statement of co-accused, the admisibility and veracity of which is yet to be tested.

4. Pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 27.2.2019, the petitioner is stated to have joined investigation.
5. Having regard to the aforesaid factual position especially that the petitioner was not arrested at the spot and has joined investigation, in my opinion, it is a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail. The petition, as such, is accepted. The petition, as such, is accepted and interim directions issued vide order dated 27.2.2019 are made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear and join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
6. The present petition stands accepted accordingly.
