Present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.93 dated 13.06.2018 under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code (for short, 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

The petitioners are involved in a case of commission of offence under Sections 326 IPC and other sections for causing injuries to four persons and injury attracting provisions of Section 326 IPC, to two persons. The petitioners are, thus, required for the purpose of investigation.

In view of the above, since the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is required in the matter for the purpose of effective investigation, no ground is made out for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners and the present petition is dismissed.
