As per averments made in the petition, petitioner was issued a Passport on 24.3.2006 and which was valid up to 5.11.2008.

Instant petition has been filed raising a grievance that even though an application has been filed before the concerned Passport authorities for issuance of a fresh Passport, no final decision thereupon has been taken.

Mr. Vijay Kumar Chaudhary, Advocate, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents. A complete copy of the writ paper book already stands furnished to the counsel representing the respondents.

Statement of learned counsel representing the respondents is recorded to the effect that in case an application for issuance of a Passport has been filed by the petitioner, the same would be processed in accordance with law and a final decision would be conveyed to the petitioner within a period of three months from today.
