Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.35 dated 26.01.2018 under Section 307 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Hodal, District Palwal.

Memo of appearance filed on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is in custody since 26.01.2018 and injured persons are residents of the same area, rather they are neighbours and with the intervention of respectable, they have settled the dispute. Trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bar any more, so, he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel affirmed the factum of custody however, opposed the bail on the ground that it is a case of fire arm injury to two persons, so the petitioner does not deserve the concession of bail.

Learned counsel representing respondents No.2 and 3 affirmed the fact regarding compromise having been effected between the parties.

Having considered the submission made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 26.01.2018 and the parties have amicably settled their dispute; the trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bar any more, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be admitted on regular bail on furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
