INDERJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.51 dated 04.09.2018, registered at Police Station City Morinda, District Rupnagar, under Sections 420 and 406 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

Allegation against the present petitioner is that he has taken Rs.5,10,000/- from complainant-Sukhwinder Singh for sending him to Germany.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a false case

has been got registered by the complainant against the present petitioner as both of them were working together as labourers in Dubai.

ASI Samarjit Singh, investigating officer, who is present in the Court, admits that during investigation, it has been found that the petitioner and complainant were working together in Dubai.

The petitioner has been in custody since 05.02.2019. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
