The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.108 dated 17.06.2017, registered under Sections 323, 506, 427, 354, 452, 148, 149 IPC, at Police Station Samana, [District Patiala.

It has been submitted that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and no role has been attributed to him. However, his name has been entered in the supplementary statement

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 27.02.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
