Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 2 to 4 to fairly investigate into FIR No. 294 dated 01.11.2018, registered under Sections 452, 323, 506 of the IPC at Police Station City Khanna-I, District Ludhiana and also to register a cross FIR.

Reply, by way of affidavit of DSP, Sub Division, Khanna, District Ludhiana, is filed in Court today and the same is taken on record. As per reply, after investigation, FIR No. 294 was registered and after conducting detailed inquiry, vide report dated 19.11.2018, it was found that the injuries suffered by the petitioner were not caused by the private respondents but were on account of petitioner falling on the ground. In para 8 of the reply, it is stated that as many as eight cases are registered against the petitioner though on the basis of the compromise, in some of the cases,

he stands acquitted by the Court.

Since the petitioner has an alternative remedy of filing a complaint before the Illaqua Magistrate for registration of a cross case, this petition is disposed of as infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to petitioner to approach the Illaqua Magistrate by way of a complaint, in accordance with law.
