JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 5 to take legal action against respondent No.6, who has illegally encroached the government land.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 - Deputy Commissioner, Jhajjar to consider and decide the representations dated 17.1.2017 and 18.9.2018 (Annexures P-3 and P-4 respectively) in the light of observations made in the letter dated 17.11.2016 (Annexure P-2), expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr.SK Saini, AAG, Haryana in the Court today.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the

case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 -Deputy Commissioner, Jhajjar to consider and decide the representations dated 17.1.2017 and 18.9.2018 (Annexures P-3 and P-4 respectively) considering the observations made in the letter dated 17.11.2016 (Annexure P-2), within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
