Petitioner Sushil @ Silla has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.1014 dated 18.12.2018, registered at Police Station Assandh, Karnal, under Sections 307, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel and counsel for respondent No.2 have appeared.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Learned counsel for petitioner as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 states that compromise has already been effected between the parties and a petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise

has already been filed before this Court.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 27.02.2019, passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose would be served by sending him to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the compromise between the parties; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 27.02.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
