Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is to set aside the order dated 18.03.2017 (Annexure P-6) passed by Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phillaur in case FIR No.149 dated 09.08.2010 under Sections 406, 498-A, 120-B of IPC registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar, whereby the application filed by the prosecution for allowing the recording of evidence of the victim Charanjit Kaur through video conferencing was dismissed.
