AJAY TEWARI, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.257 dated 04.07.2017 registered under Sections 15 and 29 of the NDPS Act and Sections 420, 467, 468 , 471 IPC at Police Station Kundli District Sonipat.

Learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner was named in the third disclosure of the main accused. Further he has argued that no other case is pending against the petitioner. He has further argued that in another petition filed by another co-accused this Court has stayed the passing of the final order and in the circumstances, it is not known when that interim order will be vacated.

Custody certificate filed in Court dated 08.04.2019 by Shahid

is taken on record. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner has undergone 01 year 07 months and 20 days of custody.

Learned Assistant Advocate General has accepted the above said factual assertions.

Keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly. Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Illaqa Magistrate/CJM/trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
