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**GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)**

The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.195 dated 23.12.2015 registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, District Amritsar City under Sections 336, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 5.3.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Amritsar has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioners/accused Balwinder Singh @ Chaudar, Sukhwinder Singh @

Mukhwinder Singh and Satnam Singh and also of complainant Gagandeep Singh and Baldev Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves with the intervention of respectables and they have no objection in case the FIR is quashed.

The learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Amritsar has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.195 dated 23.12.2015 registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, District Amritsar City under Sections 336, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
