ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 135, dated 20.08.2017, under Sections 302, 307, 323, 324, 452, 447, 511, 506, 427, 120-B, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short); Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act and Section 3(1) (x), 3 (2) (v) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 registered at Police Station Lopoke, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no injury has been attributed to the petitioner on the deceased. The petitioner has been attributed a gun shot injury to the injured Sahib Singh, who has now fully recovered from the injury. The petitioner is in custody for about 02 years and 04 months. He is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Jagbir Singh states that 05 out of 36 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for about 02 years and 04 month, he is not involved in any other case and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
