Present petition has been filed under Section 438 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.2885 dated 10.09.2016, under Section 135 of the Indian Electricity (Supply) Act, 2003, registered at Police Station Power & Irrigation Rewari, District Rewari.

While issuing notice of motion, this Court passed the following order on 28.02.2019:-

“Contends that neither the alleged electricity meter is in the name of the petitioner; nor he is owner of the land/premises in question.

Notice of motion for 08.04.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under

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Section 438(2) Cr.P.C .”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Devinder Singh has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required in this case.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 28.02.2019 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the present petition is disposed off.
