This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant
of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.122 dated 12.07.2018
registered under Sections 324, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Rampura,
District Rewari.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that in this case actually
the petitioner had suffered very serious injuries (to which Section 326 IPC
has been attracted) while the alleged injuries attributed to the petitioner is
under Section 324 IPC.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Dinesh Kumar has accepted these factual assertions.

Keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail by the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
