The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for setting aside the impugned order dated 28.11.2018, passed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib and order dated 28.03.2018, passed by the learned Sub Division Magistrate, Khamano, in the application under Section 125 Cr.P.C., filed by the respondents.

As per the aforesaid order dated 28.11.2018, the petitioner is working as a technical officer in Syndicate Bank and earning Rs.1,10,000/- per month.

After going through the material available on record, this court is of the view that an amount of Rs.6500/- per month as maintenance granted to the respondents i.e. Rs.2500/- to respondent No.1-wife and Rs.4,000/- per month to respondent No.2-minor son is highly meagre.

In view of above, no case is made out to interfere in the impugned orders as well as in the maintenance granted to the respondents.

However, the executing court shall make efforts for amicable settlement by

referring the matter to the Mediation & Conciliation Centre at Fatehgarh Sahib.

With the aforesaid direction, the instant petition stands disposed of.
