The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.40 dated 11.03.2018, registered under Sections 304-B, 306 IPC (Section 304-B IPC deleted later on) at Police Station Sadar Jalalabad, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced the photocopy of the statements of PW-1 Nirvail Singh and PW-2 Baljinder Singh, which is taken on record, wherein, it has been stated that none of the accused has been maltreated Kirandeep Kaur. She was suffering from depression. It is further submitted that one of the accused Gurminder Singh @ Billa has been granted bail.

The petitioner is in custody since 12.03.2018. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the

petitioner in custody.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Bhupinder Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.
