Petitioner-Sushila has filed this petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of direction to respondent-State to transfer the investigation of the case bearing FIR No.12 dated 08.01.2019 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 365 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 328, 302, 201, 406 and 420 of IPC (added later on) at Police Station Rai, District Sonapat to an independent agency like respondent No.6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the dead body of the deceased has not been recovered which was allegedly thrown in the Ganges. However, it is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner that accused stands arrested and is in judicial custody.

Since the FIR is registered recently on 08.01.2019 and the investigation is in progress, therefore, at this stage no ground for

transferring the investigation to any independent agency is made out

Consequently, petition is dismissed.
