This writ petition was filed assailing the orders dated 13.10.1998 and 17.11.1998 passed by respondent No. 2, viz., the Managing Director of National Hydroelectric Power Corporation Limited, whereby the petitioner was allegedly denied promotion to the grade of Senior Manager (Civil).

When this matter was taken up for hearing on 21.11.2019, there was no representation for the petitioner or his learned counsel but Mr. Lokesh Sinhal, learned counsel for respondent No. 2, informed this Court that the petitioner had expired. At his request, the matter was adjourned to enable him to produce proof thereof.

Today, Annexure R 2/2 death certificate is produced, which evidences that the petitioner died as long back as on 3.5.2001. Annexure R 2/3 demonstrates that the legal representatives of the deceased writ petitioner submitted an application for releasing his terminal benefits and in response thereto, the terminal dues were disbursed, as is evidenced by Annexure R2/4.

In the light of the aforestated facts, the writ petition is dismissed as having abated.

No order as to costs.

Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stand dismissed.
