Application sent by petitioner-Beera through regd. post to the office of Hon'ble the Chief Justice of this Court, was treated as criminal writ petition and was taken on judicial side.

This Court, vide order dated 01.03.2019, while issuing notice of motion which was accepted by learned State counsel, directed the State to file status report.

On 19.03.2019, learned State counsel submitted that younger daughter of the petitioner, aged about 12 years, was recovered and FIR had already been registered and the girl was kept in the Orphanage Home by the Child Welfare Committee, who would be handed over to her parents later on.

As regarding second girl, learned State counsel has filed the status report in the Court today, which is taken on record. It is stated in the status report that Surjit Kaur, another daughter of the petitioner, has also been recovered. Their statements under Section 164 Cr.P.C. have also been recorded. They have also been medico-legally examined.

In view of the above, no further action is required in this criminal writ petition.
