Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as well as her family members from the hands of respondent Nos. 3 to 5 and to decide the representation of the petitioner, dated 03.03.2018 (Annexure P-3).

Reply, by way of affidavit of DSP (Investigation), Ludhiana (Rural), is on record and as per the same, the petitioner was repeatedly give notice to join investigation, however, she did not appear before the police and accordingly, it was recommended by the DSP to file the complaint, which was also approved by Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana (Rural). It is further stated in the reply that family members of the petitioner are habitual offenders and are involved in following cases:
