Present appeal emanates from judgment dated 21.1.2019 passed by Family Court at Panipat whereby petition filed by husband-Naresh for annulment of marriage was dismissed.

During the pendency of the appeal, matter was referred to mediation & conciliation centre of this Court.

Both learned counsel have apprised the Court that matter has been amicably settled and settlement has been reduced into writing. Out of an amount of ₹ 18 lacs to be remitted by the appellant to the respondent, ₹ 5 lakhs has already been paid.

Under the circumstances, parties are at liberty to approach the court of competent jurisdiction by way of a joint petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act.

Both learned counsel submit that parties shall adhere to all the terms and conditions of settlement. They shall be entitled to seek waiver off statutory period of six months in view of judgment titled as **Amardeep Singh v. Harveen Kaur**; 2017 (8) SCC 746.
