This writ petition was filed assailing the selection of the fifth respondent, B.L. Sharma, as the Deputy Central Registrar of the Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research, Chandigarh.

There was no representation for the petitioner or his learned counsel when the matter was taken up for hearing on 21.11.2019. However, to enable the learned counsel to advance arguments in the event the cause of action still survives, the matter was adjourned to 9.12.2019 and notice was ordered to the petitioner.

Today, yet again, there is no representation for the petitioner and the report submitted by the Registry reflects that notice could not be served upon the petitioner as he is no longer available at the given address.

Mr. Arun Nehra, learned counsel representing the fourth respondent, would inform this Court that the fifth respondent would be

over 74 years of age, going by the averments made by the petitioner himself and in any event, both of them would not be in service as on date.

The writ petition is accordingly dismissed for non-prosecution.
