In the present writ petition, the prayer made by the petitioner is that though the petitioner has been dismissed from service but the petitioner has moved representations for considering his case under Clause 31 (ii) of the PNB (Employees') Pension Regulations, 1995 for the grant of compassionate allowance, which applications are still pending consideration with the respondents and no final order has been passed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the representations dated 10.02.2018 and 16.10.2018 (Annexures P-6 and P-7) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representations dated 10.02.2018 and 16.10.2018 (Annexures P-6 and P-7), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representations dated 10.02.2018 and 16.10.2018 (Annexures P-6 and P-7) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
