The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 695 dated 25.08.2017, registered under Sections 109, 120-B, 147, 148, 149, 307, 124-A, 435, 332, 353, 188, 186 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody for more than three months. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as charges have yet to be framed. He further states that in another criminal case registered against the petitioner he has already been acquitted. The allegations in this case are that the petitioner was a part of mob, which was involved in setting on fire the public property.

Custody certificate dated 06.03.2019 prepared by Sh. Varun Sinwar, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Sirsa, has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. According to this certificate, the petitioner has undergone actual custody of three months and twelve days and in the other criminal case registered against him, he has been acquitted.

The factual submissions made on behalf of the petitioner have not been

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
