Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to conduct an independent judicial inquiry or investigation by the CBI in case FIR No.68 dated 07.9.2016, under Sections 353, 186, 332, 224, 225, 212, 216, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Dahramgarh, District Sangrur.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Amrik Singh has apprised the Court that the prosecution has examined 11 witnesses out of in all 18.
