The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 29.01.2019.

Reply by the respondent filed in the Court, which is taken on record. Copy given to learned counsel for the petitioner.

As per the said reply, the order has been complied with and the petitioner has since been re-instated.

In view of the same, the present contempt is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that petitioner should have paid the salary from the date of the order dated 29.01.2019 till re-instatement.

However, the writ petition is still pending. Hence, this Court does not deem it proper to proceed for the said relief in the present contempt petition. He may agitate for the said relief before the concerned Court.

It is further contended that the petitioner is being made to work under his juniors. The said argument does not help. The order of reinstatement shows that he is Senior Accountant and is continuing to work as such.

In view of the above, no order can be passed in this contempt petition.
