Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that as per the decision of the Cooperative Society, village Ubbawal, Tehsil and District Sangrur, one seat was reserved for the scheduled castes category. Petitioner being a scheduled caste candidate and eligible intended to participate in the elections by way of filing of his nomination papers, which he was not allowed by the members of the society.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that he had submitted a representation dated 28.01.2019, which was followed by further representations, but no action has been taken thereon.

Perusal of the representation, which has been submitted by the petitioner would not indicate as to who specifically did not permit him to file his nomination papers. It is a vague representation which has been submitted by the petitioner. Nothing has been produced on record that the petitioner had ever approached the office of the Cooperative Society, village Ubbawal, Tehsil and District Sangrur, for filing his nomination papers. This appears to be an afterthought by the petitioner.

The writ petition, therefore, being devoid of any factual detail (s) stands dismissed.
