AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 30.5.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 13996 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 1-Principal Secretary to Government of Punjab, Department of Higher Education, Civil Secretariat, Punjab, Chandigarh to consider the case of the petitioner in the light of assertion made within six weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the order. If, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the case of the petitioner is at par with the petitioners in the above said judgment, the competent authority is directed to pass the

consequential order within a period of 12 weeks thereafter.

However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.”

Reply by way of affidavit of Gurdarshan Singh Brar, Assistant Director (Services) O/o Director Public Instruction (Colleges), Punjab, Mohali on behalf of respondent No. 2 has been filed in court today. The same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the order of this court has been complied with. However, in case there is any grievance, liberty be granted to the petitioner to avail the remedies as are available in accordance with law.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous with liberty to avail remedies as are available in accordance with law.

Rule issued is discharged.
