FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (Oral)

Report dated 09.04.2019 of the Mediator of the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court has been received whereby after holding joint as well as individual sessions with the parties, the Mediator has reported that the private parties to this petition have settled their disputes by way of an amicable settlement/agreement reduced into writing annexed with the report.

Moreover, complainant-Mandeep Kaur, who has personally put in appearance has vouched for the compromise and got her statement recorded to the effect that she has entered into a compromise with the petitioners before the Mediation and Conciliation

Centre of this Court on 25.04.2019 out of her free will and consent and has no objection if the present FIR 0031 dated 07.10.2016 Police Station Women, SAS Nagar Mohali is quashed reserving her rights to get the FIR revived in case the petitioners fail to perform their obligation as undertaken before the Mediation Centre of this Court.

Heard.

In the light of the report of the Mediator and statement made by the complainant in person before this Court which is reduced into writing and considering the fact that the offence for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 0031 dated 07.10.2016 registered at Police Station Women SAS Nagar Mohali under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.

However, in case of any future eventuality if the accused/petitioners back out of their undertaking, complainant-

Mandeep Kaur is at liberty to get revived the FIR.
