“It is therefore respectfully prayed that this petition may kindly be allowed the respondents be directed to record the version of the petitioner as cross-version in case/FIR No.37 dated 13.02.2017 under Section 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Lopoke, in terms of Section 154(3) Cr.P.C. and further for directing that the enquiry of the aforesaid FIR be got conducted fairly and impartially by an officer not below the rank of IPS, in the interest of justice.”
