This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for directing the trial Court to release the petitioner on bail in the event of her arrest in case FIR No.23 dated 16.02.2017 registered under Sections 420, 406 IPC and under Section 13 of the PTPR Act, 2014 at P.S. Division 7, Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner was on regular bail and inadvertently she noted the date as 02.08.2018 instead of 02.07.2018 and could not appear on one date due to this reason and otherwise she was regularly appearing.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Amarjit Kaur Khurana, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

Copy of the paper book has been supplied.

In the opinion of this Court, if the aforesaid assertion is correct

then one more opportunity should be granted to the petitioner. Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the trial Court on the next date which is stated to be 27.03.2019 and in case it is correct that she has never misused the concession of bail earlier, the trial Court shall release her on bail to its satisfaction.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
