Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.219 dated 12.11.2018, registered at Police Station Sadar Nakodar, District Jalandhar Rural, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that in the present case, 150 tablets containing the salt of 'Alprazolam' were recovered. The aforesaid recovery

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falls in non-commercial quantity.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 07.03.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. She is not required for custodial interrogation. Recovery has already been effected. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 07.03.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
