Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.2 dated 05.01.2019 under Sections 417, 420, 376, 494, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is a compromise dated 18.01.2019 (Annexure P-2) between the complainant and the family members of the petitioner and she has no objection even if the petitioner was already married with Shama.

ASI Rajesh Kumar has identified the complainant present in the Court along with her father. Learned State Counsel does not dispute the custody.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Taking into consideration the compromise-deed dated

18.01.2019 (Annexure P-2), whereby no objection has been given by the

complainant, who is present in the Court, this Court finds that the petitioner deserves to be admitted on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
