This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with the following substantive prayer:

“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to quash FIR No.43 dated 1.2.2016 (Annexure P-48) under sections 34, 384 and 506 IPC registered at Police Station, Civil Lines, Rohtak, Distt.Rohtak qua the petitioners being false, frivolous, concocted, malafide, based on oblique reasons and extraneous consideration with a view to harass and humiliate the petitioners and further also quash all the subsequent proceedings against the petitioners in pursuance of the above noted FIR. In the interest of justice, equity and fair play.

It is further prayed that during the pendency of the present petition, the further all proceedings qua the petitioners in the pursuance of the above noted FIR be stayed before the learned trial Court in the interest of justice, equity and fair play.”

Reply by way of affidavit has been filed in which it has been

pointed out that on completion of investigation, no proof regarding demand

of ransom by the petitioners was found by the police and a cancellation report has been written by the police on 17.8.2016.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh submits that the aforesaid cancellation report has already been submitted in the Court.

In view thereof, the present petition been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
