GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking protection of their lives and liberty as they apprehend threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that both the petitioners are major and while petitioner No.1 is aged more than 24 years, the petitioner No.2 is aged more than 18 years. It has been submitted that both the petitioners fell in love with each other and started living together since 22.02.2019 but the said arrangement is not approved by the members of the family of petitioner No.1 i.e. respondent No.4 to 6 and who have been

issuing threats of dire consequences to the petitioners. It has further been submitted that although a representation dated 22.02.2019 (Annexure P-5) has been made to respondent No.2 but necessary steps have not been taken thereupon.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Hissar to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-5) expeditiously and in case, it is found that there is any imminent threat then it be ensured that no harm is caused to the petitioners in any manner.
4. It is, however, made clear that this order shall not be deemed to confer any immunity upon petitioners from any action warranted under law for having committed any offence or wrong.
5. A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-5) be sent to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Hissar so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
