The petitioners are the NRIs. A criminal case against respondent no.4 was got registered under Sections 448, 406 and 506 IPC on 01.12.2018 at Police Station NRI, Patiala on the basis of the complaint submitted by petitioner No.1.

It is the case of the petitioners that they are receiving threats by respondent No.4 not to pursue the FIR in question. In this regard, the petitioners also moved a representation dated 23.02.2019 to respondent No.2 to provide protection to the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondent No. 4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to look into the representation(Annexure P-2) and take such appropriate action as may be warranted in law.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation(Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioners and take such action as may be warranted in law.
