The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.13 dated 19.01.2019, under Sections 295-A, 323, 506 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the FIR is outcome of a sudden altercation on account of Panchayat elections. No one was injured in the occurrence.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 28.02.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Dalwinder Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation, the order dated 28.02.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
