Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 7.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Amarjit Kaur Khurana, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and Mr. Sarvesh Kumar Gupta, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of the respondents No.4 and 5.

Counsel for the petitioner undertakes to supply requisite copies of the paper book to the learned DAG and learned counsel for respondents No. 4 and 5 during the course of the day.

Counsel for the respondents No.4 and 5 -parents of the petitioner No.1 pray that they may be allowed to meet petitioner No.1.

Request has been accepted. The mother of the girl met the petitioner No.1 in the Chamber of this Court. Even thereafter the daughter-petitioner No.1 is adamant that she wants to live with the boy-petitioner No.2.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. Both the petitioners are stated to be major. In support of his proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) wherein her year of birth is mentioned as 1997 whereas petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) depicting his year of birth as 1994. They have also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali, Punjab (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali, Punjab to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
