The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest in FIR No.88 dated 05.02.2016 under Sections 323, 498-A, 406 and 377 of IPC registered at Police Station City Sonapat, District Sonapat.

The aforesaid FIR was got registered at the instance of the wife of the petitioner.

Vide order dated 09.05.2016 passed by this Court the petitioner was granted interim bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 09.05.2016 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
