1. Learned counsel states that the prayer of the petitioners who are working as extension lecturers is to be allowed to continue in service till regularly selected candidates join and even thereafter to be allowed to continue in service in terms of instructions Annexure P/1 dated 13.07.2018.

2. Learned counsel states that the petitioners have submitted representations Annexure P/3 and P/4 dated 05.02.2019 but the same have not been decided till date and in the circumstances, the petitioners would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the claim as made in representations Annexure P/3 and P/4 dated 05.02.2019, in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

3. Without commenting on the merits of the claim, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide representations Annexure P/3 and P/5 dated 05.02.2019, within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
