MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.289 dated 29.12.2018, under Sections 420 and 406 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Division No.4, District Ludhiana.

While issuing notice of motion, this Court passed the following order on 28.02.2019:-

“Contends that affiliation of the School has been declined by the C.B.S.E. on two occasions and the petitioner has nothing to do with the same.

Notice of motion for 08.04.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner

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is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under

Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Janak Raj has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required in this case.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 28.02.2019 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the present petition is disposed off.
