For the reasons stated in the application, same is allowed and the main case, which is otherwise fixed for hearing on 10.12.2019, is taken on board today itself.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to transfer the investigation of FIR No.125 dated 04.08.2018 registered under Section 376 of IPC at

Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga, to some independent agency or to the Crime Branch, Chandigarh. Prayer has also been made to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner does not press the relief of transfer of investigation and confines her prayer to the life and liberty of the petitioner. She states that since the accused has been admitted on anticipatory bail, he is extending threat to the petitioner to withdraw the case.

Notice of motion only to respondents No.1 to 3 at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Jasleen Kaur Sidhu, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case and considering the limited prayer of the petitioner qua protection of her life and liberty, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction that in case the petitioner submits a representation for protection of her life and liberty to the concerned Superintendent of Police, the same shall be dealt with in accordance with law.
