The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.10 dated 08.02.2019 under Section 420 of IPC, registered at Police Station Bareta, District Mansa.

On 09.04.2019, the learned counsel for the petitioner had submitted that the petitioner is ready to make the payments to the aggrieved persons and to settle the dispute. Therefore, the case was adjourned to explore the possibilities of compromise between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has since been settled between the parties. Now, the complainant does not have any grievance against the petitioner.

Mr. Siddharth Gupta, Advocate, appearing on behalf of the complainant, has also not disputed the fact that the parties have since compromised the dispute.

In view of the above, it would not be unjustified, if the petitioner is granted protection against his arrest.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case, the petitioner is arrested by the Investigating Officer in connection with the present case, then the petitioner shall be released on bail, subject to his furnishing bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as mentioned in Section 438 Cr.P.C.
