This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 27.5.2016 passed in CWP No. 10742 of 2016.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

'After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, perusing the present petition and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, we dispose of the present petition by directing respondent No.1 to take a decision on the legal notice dated 17.2.2016 (Annexure P-4), in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.'

Reply has been filed today annexing the order dated 2.8.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will have to challenge the order dated 2.8.2019.

The contempt petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail remedy in accordance with law to challenge the order dated 2.8.2019.

Rule issued against the respondents is hereby discharged.
