Present revision petition has been filed by the petitioner against the impugned judgment dated 02.02.2019, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rupnagar, vide which, first part of the judgment, passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Rupnagar, regarding conviction of petitioner under Sections 464, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 409, IPC was upheld, but second part of the judgment with regard to the quantum of sentence, thereby releasing the petitioner on probation, has been set aside with a direction to learned trial Court to pass the fresh order on quantum of sentence in accordance with law.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner instead of assailing the impugned judgment, has confined his prayer only up to the extent that at the time of passing of the fresh order on quantum of sentence by learned trial Court, the petitioner be heard.

Prayer seems to be justified and accepted.

It is made clear that learned trial Court, while considering the quantum of sentence in pursuance of directions dated 02.02.2019, shall hear the petitioner and thereafter, the fresh order shall be passed in accordance with law.

Disposed off accordingly.
