Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 and 5.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Amarjit Kaur Khurana, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Counsel for the petitioner has supplied requisite copies of the paper book to the learned DAG during the course of the day.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. Both the petitioners are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record Voter Card (Annexure P-2) wherein her year of birth is mentioned as 15.10.1996 whereas

petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-3) depicting his date of birth as 30.8.1990. They have also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) Amritsar, Punjab (Annexure P-6) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) Amritsar, Punjab to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-6).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
